





## Dues Relief and Membership Deferral Policy

The Royal Society of Canada offers Members in good standing accommodations for membership dues relief or deferral.

In order to provide relief or deferral of annual membership dues, the RSC requires notice from the Member prior to June 30 (the RSC fiscal year begins on July 1). Dues relief or deferral applies for one year.

One or more of the following conditions usually applies for a Member seeking dues relief or deferral:

- 1 The Member is not working due to illness, disability, or parental leave;
- 2. The Member is not gainfully employed;
- 3. The Member is experiencing other circumstances which merit dues relief;

In order to provide notice of dues relief or deferral, the Member is required to email <a href="mailto:rscfinance@rsc-src.ca">rscfinance@rsc-src.ca</a> with their name, Membership Number, and allusion to the conditions that inhibit regular dues remittance.

Please note that processing a notice of dues relief or deferral usually requires up to two weeks.
